The Arjo Maxi Twin Hoist has a twin mast which improves stability and weight distribution of the hoist. It also allows a further reach so that it is easier to hoist someone from a bed without having to reposition them. The longer reach also means that someone can be hoisted from the floor if needed. The gap between the masts means that eye contact can be made throughout hoisting.

The sling fits onto the frame and can be easily rotated 360°, even during use. The hoist is operated via an electronic control so the entire hoist is very easy and simple to manoeuvre. All these features combine for safe, smooth and comfortable hoisting

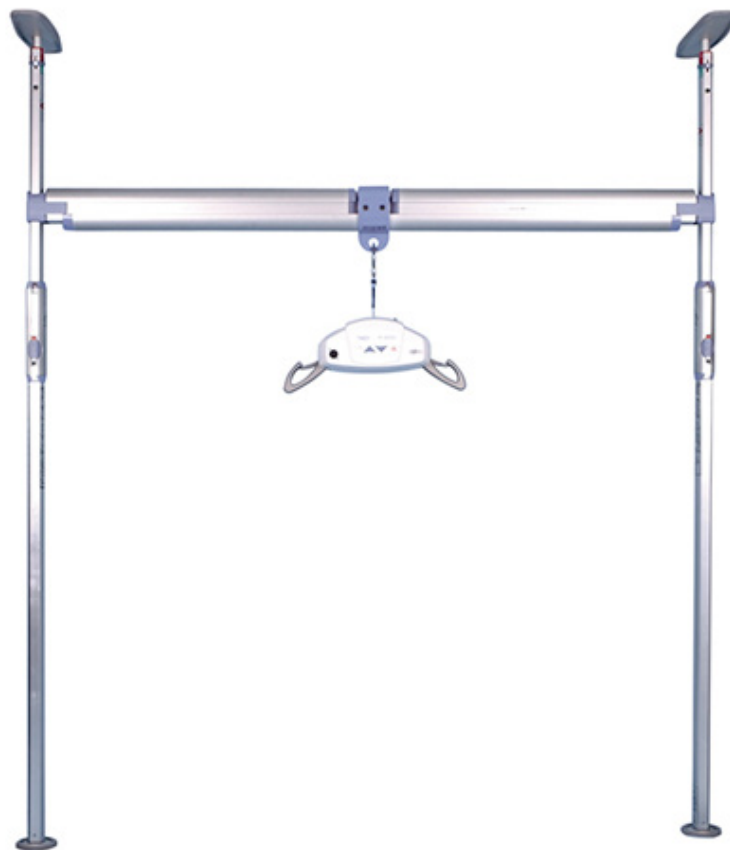

OUR POLICIES

Disability hoist hire source, test, train, deliver and repair with health and safety in mind. Disability hoist hire operate to the highest British and International quality service standards.

EMPLOYERS HEALTH AND SAFETY RESPONSIBILITIES

All of our hoist equipment and training complies with The Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998. Employers have a responsibility to provide hoisting equipment as stated in the Manual Handling Regulations 1992. The Manual Handling Regulations say that your employer must allow you to:

- 

Avoid manual handling wherever possible, eg by using hoists or other equipment.
- 


Assess the risks and reduce them as far as is reasonably practicable.

Disability Hoist Hire recommends that a risk assessment is performed for all individuals with reduced mobility. We also recommend that you:

- 


Have an overall policy for risk management and how this should fit in to each care plan.
- 


Provide carers with adequate training in safer handling techniques, use of equipment and provide regular refresher training.


- 


Supply assistive devices, such as hoists, wheelchairs and walking/standing aids, and maintain them properly.

A good risk assessment will include:

- 

Details of the client's height, weight and abilities.
- 

Recommended ways of moving clients for each individual transfer (chair to bed, bed to chair, chair to bath, bath to chair etc).
- 

The minimum number of staff needed for each task.
- 

Transfer arrangements for both day and night-time care.



TRAINING

The value of hoist and manual handling training is increasingly recognised as regulations become ever more stringent. It is essential that care providers of all levels possess and maintain the skills to ensure their own and others safety at work. Disability Hoist Hire provide a high standard of training programmes to meet your all of your training needs. Certificates of attendance are provided for CPD and NVQ purposes.

HOIST TRAINING

Our comprehensive hoist training programme can be provided for individuals or groups with one or more hoists. Training can be organised on your premises at a time that is convenient for you and your organisation. Training is usually provided with your own hoists and slings, however, hoists and slings can be provided for training sessions if required.

RISK ASSESSMENT

Risk assessments and risk assessment reports can be provided by Disability Hoist Hire. These assessments and reports can outline the potential risks involved in hoisting and transfers and make recommendations regarding safe methods of transferring and positioning individuals.

MANUAL HANDLING TRAINING

Disability Hoist Hire provide manual handling training tailored to your individual needs. This training normally includes hoist training but the inclusion of hoist training is not compulsory. Training can be adapted to suit the needs of your workplace and the tasks that are carried out on or off your premises. Disability Hoist Hire can provide this legally required training for a range of individuals from carers to office workers to construction workers. Areas covered can be tailored to meet your needs.

Areas commonly covered include; basic spinal anatomy and biomechanics, types and mechanisms of manual handling injuries, the identification and reduction of risks during work practices and the demonstration and practice of basic handling techniques.
